2020 TDI Market Development & Current Environment

Main Markets Highly Impacted by the Pandemic



- Global TDI demand reduced by 7,9%* in 2020 with all main regions being impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic
- Most impacted regions were Europe and APAC
- Latin America was the region with the best performance shrinking only 1%
- APAC is the biggest largest global market with more than 50% of the global demand. Latin America represents 6,7% of the Global TDI demand
- Brazil presented a performance above regional demand as indicated by Public Import Statistics

Current Environment

- Global markets remains tight in supply
- Several producers remain on Force Majeure, specially in North America (public announcements)
- Global supply chain remains unstable Logistics and Raw Materials
